

# UCC Schools 2020-21 Enrollment Information

## Frequently Asked Questions/Answers

### 1. How do I enroll my child in BGCS?

- b. We are currently in a period of open enrollment, and if you want to leave your name and number we can have our Enrollment Specialist, Sandra Astorga, call you to discuss the details with you. We would encourage to try to attend one of these Open House sessions:
  - Saturday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2019 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
  - Wednesday, January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.
  - Thursday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.

### 2. What grades are you enrolling?

- a. We currently have open spots for K3 at Bruce-Guadalupe Community School and 6<sup>th</sup> grade at UCC Acosta Middle School. We will accept applications for other grades for our waiting list, but will not know availability until the summer.

### 3. What if I have one K3 or 6<sup>th</sup> grade and another child at an upper grade and I want them both here?

- a. Again, we are currently open to enroll new K3 and 6<sup>th</sup> grade, and will happily put your other child on our wait list. As we will not know if there are spaces available until later in the year. Until then, we would encourage you to keep them enrolled in their current school and as soon as we are aware of opening we will be in touch with you. We cannot guarantee a spot, but will do our best to accommodate your needs.

### 4. How much does this school cost?

- a. Both Bruce-Guadalupe Community School and UCC Acosta Middle School are both public schools, and therefore grades K5-8<sup>th</sup> are fully funded by the State. Since K3 and K4 are not fully funded by the State of Wisconsin, there are fees associated with those grade levels. Our enrollment specialist will share cost details with you as well as options to apply for Head Start, Wisconsin Shares, and/or other payment options during your informational meeting.

### 5. What are the school hours?

Bruce-Guadalupe Community School:

Preschool K3, K4 and K5 – 8:00 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.

Elementary K5 to 5<sup>th</sup> grade – 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Middle School 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grade – 7:45 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

UCC Acosta Middle School:

Middle School 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grade - 7:45 a.m. to 3:40 p.m.

### 6. Do you have after school program?

- a. All UCC schools have early drop off at 7:30 a.m. and after school options until 5:00 p.m.

### 7. Do you have summer school program?

- a. All UCC schools have 20 days of summer school for K5 to 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. All new K5-8<sup>th</sup> grade students for the 2020-21 who are enrolled before summer school are expected to participate in the program. This coming summer school 2020 will have 5 weeks, Monday to Thursday, June 15<sup>th</sup> to July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Summer school classes are half day in the morning 7:45 a.m. to 12:15 p.m. and you will have opportunity to enroll your child in the summer recreation 12:15 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
